A NEW RESOLUTION

It is that time of year again. With a new year comes New Year Resolutions. Often times they are tied to our physical wellbeing: a diet, a workout regiment, etc. Sometimes our resolutions strive to improve our personal habits: being on time, being more patient. We may resolve to act differently toward others. And we may add some spiritual discipline to our resolutions: more time in prayer or Bible reading.

Resolutions are not bad things in and of themselves. Many people fear them because they know from experience the abysmal feeling of failure the first time a resolution is broken. If we remember the grace and forgiveness of God as we attempt to carry them out, they will not be too burdensome for us. Let's each pick out for ourselves one special person a month, identify their unique love language, and be sure we communicate God's love and ours to them in the language they best understand. It won't be that easy. The temptations to forget, to quit, to become discouraged, are great. It will take our mutual encouragement, timely reminders, and prayer to accomplish this. But, the results will be tremendous!

Imagine the change in attitudes of those who experience God's love in the special way they best understand. Imagine the growth in love of those who experiment in communicating love in differ-

Outdoor work will begin at 8:00AM and indoor work will begin at 9:00AM.



Sunshine Acres Children's Home is located in Mesa. Since 1954, Sunshine Acres has been home to more than 1600 children. Founded by Rev. Jim and Vera Dingman, this faith mission has two basic principles: *We*

never solicit money, or a board, or a brick and No child will ever be turned away for financial reasons. The home is almost entirely funded by donations and their focus is the quality care of the children and not fundraising.
