## ANNIVERSARIES

2017 is a banner year here at Trinity. Our congregation will be celebrating our 25th year of ministry all year long. A special committee headed up by Todd Wittlinger has been hard at work planning for multiple events that will help in our celebrations.

2017 is also the 500th anniversary of the Reformation. That's right, half a millennium ago a simple German monk named Martin Luther began his quest to call the Christian Church back to its original Apostolic faith. Since the Great Commissioning given by Jesus, the church had lost its focus and its voice. Too many man-made philosophies and doctrines had diluted the clear

proclamation of God's love for us in Jesus Christ. Prompted by the Holy Spirit, Martin Luther called the church back to three core values that would once again set her on the course that God Himself had given.

**Grace Alone:** Simply knowing that God's love and salvation are given to all through Jesus; without favor or merit on their part.

**Faith Alone:** Our access to God's saving love is by the connection we have through the Holy Spirit to love and trust Him above all things; not any works we ourselves perform.

**Scripture Alone:** Our complete and final source of all knowledge and faith is from God's Holy Word; nothing else

is needed and nothing else is accepted. These three core values were at the heart of the Reformation, and they remain at the heart of our ministry here at Trinity. We thank God for inspired, brave and visionary people like Luther, and those who founded our congregation 25 years ago, who kept faith with the faith. May God continue His blessings to us as we remain faithful to Him, reaching out with the truth of His love and favor for all in Jesus our Savior.
