Reformation Month

As members of the Lutheran Church, we normally think of October as Reformation month, or as the birth date of our church. (It was on All Hallows Eve that Luther nailed the Ninety-five Thesis to the church door in Wittenberg) In keeping with this long held tradition, I think a little reflection on the true meaning of the Reformation for our day is in order.

Martin Luther never wanted to found a new, or alternative church. His desire was only to reform, or correct, the entire Christian Church of his day. The fact that the church needed reforming is a reminder to us

that the church itself can easily fall into error and trouble. We need to be vigilant, especially in our day, that we do not follow in the false paths of our predecessors. To keep ourselves in the narrow way of true faith and doctrine, some of the Reformation emphasis is essential.

We need to remember that no one church is the single source of salvation. Wherever the Bible is shared and taught, and the good news of Jesus as our Savior is announced, we can be sure that salvation is present for all those who believe. The challenge for every generation in every church is to humbly place ourselves beneath the Word of God and let Him speak to us. We are also responsible to our brothers and sisters in the faith, as they are to us, to help them see errors and correct problems. Spiritually, no one is an island; we are all our brothers' keepers.

We need to remember that God's Word is true and accurate. It is the only source we have to know the mind and will of God. It is never for us to tell God what we want Him to say to us. Instead, we listen attentively to what we need to hear from Him. From His Word we learn true repentance. Through His Word we have sure forgiveness. In His Word we have the necessary motivation and direction to amend our sinful and straying ways.

We need to remember the graciousness of God's coming to us. The Christian Faith is not about what we do for God; but what He has and continues to do for us. He came as our Savior. He meets us in the proclamation of His Word and the celebration of His Sacraments. He is there whenever we call out to Him. In short, what we as sinners so often forget or confuse is: It is not all about us- but all about Him!

We need to remember that there is no limit to the grace of our God. We can never sin so much or so greatly that we outstrip His willingness and ability to freely and fully forgive us. This is not license then to sin; but loving motivation to receive God's love and the strength and change for new living it provides. It is God who makes all things new.

Finally, we need to remember that God never leaves Himself without a witness to the truth for us. No matter how far we stray or confused we become, He will always be there to search us out and return us to Himself. Even if we are faithless, He remains faithful!

These are the things of the Reformation we celebrate and give thanks for. May God, by His Holy Spirit, continue to call us in the truth, toward the truth.

JUST A REMINDER: WE ARE STILL SAVING STAMPS FOR MISSIONS

Commemorative Larger than the common stamp size; all sides must have perforations. A stamp that has one smooth side is considered a common stamp.

High-dollar Any stamps that cost more than the current first-class stamp.

Airmail All airmail stamps.

Foreign All foreign stamps (any size, any value).

There must be at least ¼ inch of paper around each stamp. It is very important that the perforations not be damaged in the cutting of the paper. Do not remove the stamp from the paper.

Do not save stamps that are torn, bent, heavily canceled, written on, or have Scotch tape attached. Do not save preprinted postcards or postage embossed on envelopes.

Deposit stamps in the large white envelope on the outreach bulletin board, located in the hallway between the kitchen and the fellowship room.
