They will help tutor and train children and adults, and join in worship and fellowship with the congregation. Most important, they will be sharing the love that God has given to us all in Jesus Christ.

It is fitting that this mission trip begin

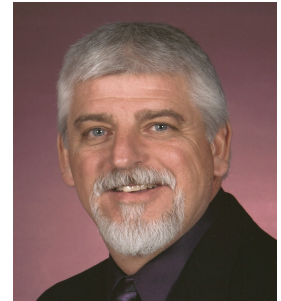

Because Jesus fulfilled His mission, we have peace with God and the assurance of everlasting life.

It is especially fitting that this mission trip take place in this particular Lenten season at Trinity. Each

Wednesday evening we will gather for fellowship and food, worship and learning. The focus of our Lenten services will be on prayer, particularly The Lord’s Prayer. No one can successfully be in mission except that they are in prayer, and prayed for.

Remember the number of times Jesus took time out during His earthly ministry to pray? Just before He began the greatest work of His mission, He paused in the Garden of Gethsemane for a most earnest prayer. We can and should do no differently.

Prayer gives us strength. Prayer gives us understanding.



Prayer keeps the Devil at bay. Prayer accomplishes great things. No mission can succeed without prayer. And so we ask two things of each of you. Keep our mission team in your prayers as they travel and share in Las Vegas. Set aside a time each day to ask the Lord’s blessings for them and their work. And join us on Wednesday evenings so that we may learn and grow together in our prayers lives.

This Lent, let each of us be “on a mission”!

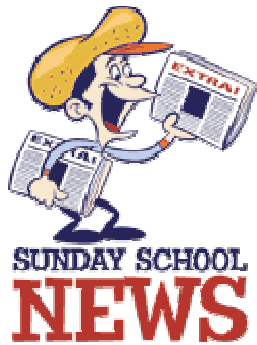

Friends are always welcome!

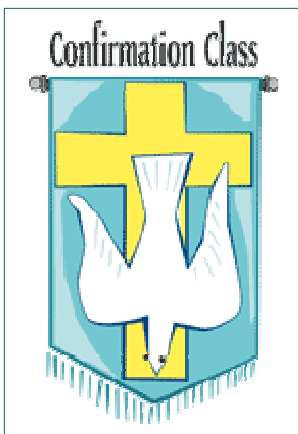
MIDDLE SCHOOL YOUTH NEWS
